THE MUNICIPALITY OF NORTH PERTH

BY-LAW NUMBER 24-2006 as amended

To Establish Rates for Licences and User Fees in the Municipality of North Perth

WHEREAS Section 220.12 of The Municipal Act authorizes a municipality and local Board to pass by-laws imposing fees or charges on any class of persons;

AND WHEREAS Section 69 of The Planning Act authorizes a municipality and local Board to pass by-laws for fees for the processing of applications made in respect of planning matters;

AND WHEREAS the municipality feels it appropriate to set out these charges in one by-law for easy access by ratepayers;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Municipality of North Perth enacts as follows:

1. The following Schedules apply to various services provided by department:
 - i) Schedule “A” Licence Fees
 - ii) Schedule “B” Administration Fees
 - iii) Schedule “C” Lottery Licence Fees
 - iv) Schedule “D” Fire Services Fees
 - v) Schedule “E” Planning & Zoning Fees
 - vi) Schedule “F” Building Permit Fees
 - vii) Schedule “G” Development Charges
 - viii) Schedule “H” Recreation Facilities Fees
 - viii) Schedule “T” Public Works Fees
 - ix) Schedule “J” Landfill Fees
 - x) Schedule “K” Dog Licence Fees
 - xi) Schedule “L” Day Care Centre Fees
 - xii) Schedule “M” Police Services Fees
 - xiii) Schedule “N” Cemetery Fees
 - xiv) Schedule “O” Library Fees

2. These rates may be amended by resolution of the Council of the Municipality of North Perth at any time.

3. Interest on any outstanding account will be charged to the individual at the rate of 2% per month. If this fee is outstanding at the end of the calendar year the amount may be added to the tax roll for collection on any real property in the municipality owned by the applicant and such licence charges and user fees may be collected in like manner as municipal taxes.

4. Council will review the rates and fees charged when deemed appropriate.

5. This By-Law comes into force upon the final passing thereof.

6. By-law No. 98-AD-2002 of the Town of North Perth is hereby repealed.

7. This By-law shall be known as the “Fees and Licenses By-law”.

HAWKERS AND PEDDLER'S LICENCE FEES
(Being Schedule “A” to By-Law No. 54-2006)

1. The Licence Fee for every person who applies for the License referred to in Clause 1. shall be the sum of One Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$150.00) for the year in which it is issued or any part thereof \$ 150.

2. ***Resident Applicant***
As per Clause 7.(b) of this By-Law, a Resident Applicant will pay one half of the stated License Fee.

3. ***Flea Market***
The Licence Fee for a Flea Market defined in Clause 2.(a) of By-Law No. 60-AD-1998 shall be paid by the promoter/organizer of the Flea Market and shall be:
 - (a) for a 1 day show \$ 350.
 - (b) for a 2 consecutive day show to a 7 consecutive day show \$ 700.
plus \$50. a day for any days in excess of seven and up to a maximum fee in any one calendar year of \$2,100.

4. ***Retail Exhibition/Trade Show***
The Licence Fee for a Retail Exhibition/Trade Show License as defined in Section 2.(b) or 2.(c) shall be paid by the promoter/organizer of the Retail Exhibition/Trade Show and shall be:
 - (a) for a 1 day exhibition \$ 350.
 - (b) for a 2 consecutive day show to a 7 consecutive day show \$ 700.
plus \$50. a day for any days in excess of seven

5. ***Agricultural Farmers Market***
The License fee for an Agricultural Farmers Market as Defined in Clause 2.(d) shall be \$ 250.
for each calendar year.

6. ***Charitable Organization/Local Service Club***
 - a) Where an application is made for a License by a bonafide Charitable Organization or a local Service Club, there will be no fee Nil
 - b) Where an organization is holding a fundraising barbecue in conjunction with a local business no licence or fee is required Nil

7. ***Signage***
Signage exceeding four (4) signs per license will be subject to confiscation without notice by Municipality of North Perth Staff or any other designated person and a fee of \$50.00 per sign shall be applicable

8. ***Disputes Regarding Application of Fees***

In cases of a dispute with regard to the application of these fees with respect to individuals or groups, the matter will be referred to Council for a final decision.

FIRE SERVICES FEES
(Being Schedule "A" to By-law 83-FI-1998)

Non-Emergency Services

1. Occupant Load Licences

The following fees shall apply to services related to the issuance and posting of licences defining the maximum occupant load of places of assembly having more than 60 persons including but not limited to public halls, arenas, auditoriums and occupancies wherein alcoholic beverages are served.

Where alcoholic beverages are served	\$75.00
All other	\$50.00

2. Inspection Under the Ontario Fire Code

Requests for special building inspections under the Ontario Fire Code requirements shall be charged at the following rates based upon category:

- **Industrial/Commercial - Single Tenant or Occupancy**
 Up to 20,000 square feet or 929 square meters - \$100.00
 Every additional 10,000 square feet or 929 square meters or part thereof - \$50.00
- **Commercial - Multiple Occupancy Complex**
 Basic inspection charge - \$ 100.00
 Each tenant or occupancy up to 10,000 square feet or 929 square meters - \$50.00
- **Residential Apartment or Condominium Buildings**
 Basic inspection charge - \$75.00
 Additional charge for each tenant, occupancy or apartment - \$2.00 per unit
- **Office Commercial**
 Basic inspection charge - \$ 75.00
 Each tenant or occupancy up to 10,000 square feet or 929 square meters - \$10.00
 per unit
- **Special Inspection - Tent or Marquee**
 Where Fire Code inspection is mandated - \$50.00 per inspection

3. Other Requests

- Request to review a fire safety plan and provide written response - \$30.00
- Requests on behalf of a purchaser or seller for inspection to be done on a home or building - \$100.00 for the initial inspection and one follow-up inspection, \$75.00 for each subsequent inspection thereafter.
- Requests for inspection of private, day, nursery or other schools. First visit - \$100.00. Each subsequent visit - \$75.00
- LLBO inspections - \$100.00 for initial inspection, \$75.00 for each subsequent inspection. Request to the fire service for inspections regarding the Resident's Rights Act, low and High rise legislation, etc. - \$100.00

4. Miscellaneous

- Copies of Departmental Fire Reports - \$50.00
- Requests for written reports pertaining to emergency calls - \$50.00
- Review of the Risk and Safety Management Plans (RSMPs) a hourly rate of \$100.00 plus additional charges for any third party review that is required for this service

FIRE SERVICES FEES
(Being Schedule "B" to By-law 83-FI-1998)

Emergency Services

1. **Motor Vehicle Incidents on Provincial Highways**

All motor vehicles accidents, fires, etc., on Provincial Highways shall be charged to the Ministry of Transportation of Ontario as per the rates set out by the Ministry of Transportation of Ontario. (\$410.00 first hour or part thereof per piece of equipment and \$205.00 each additional half hour or part thereof per piece of equipment). Charges under the Spills Act or the Transportation of Dangerous Goods Act shall be charged in addition, if applicable.

2. **Motor Vehicle Incidents at all Locations Other Than on Provincial Highways**

All motor vehicle accidents, fire, etc., involving residents or non-residents of the Municipality of North Perth at all other locations other than on Provincial Highways shall be charged as per the Ministry of Transportation of Ontario rates. (\$410.00 first hour or part thereof per piece of equipment and \$205.00 each additional half hour or part thereof per piece of equipment). Charges under the Spills Act or the Transportation of Dangerous Goods Act shall be charged in addition, if applicable.

3. **Administration and Enforcement of Spills Act and Transportation of Dangerous Goods Act**

The cleanup of hazardous material spills shall be charged out at Ministry of Transportation of Ontario's rates (\$350.00 per vehicle per hour or part thereof and \$175.00 each half hour after the first hour) plus the cost of any cleanup materials used or contracted services utilized in the cleanup.

4. **Burning Related Charges**

- Burning violations - \$300.00 per hour per vehicle required
- Emergency response to illegal open air burning under the Ontario Fire Code shall be charged \$300.00 per vehicle per hour with an additional 15 % administration fee and any associated cleanup costs required.

5. **Security of Premises**

Securing of premises after a fire by sealing doors and windows shall be charged at \$25.00 per hour per firefighter plus the cost of Public Works Department's current hourly wages and benefits plus materials used and a 15 % administration fee.

6. **False Fire Alarms**

The following procedures and fees shall apply only when it has been determined by the Chief of the Town's Fire Department that the false alarms were preventable, the fire alarms system was improperly installed or maintained or the alarm resulted from a malicious act by an individual.

The totals shall be calculated cumulatively, with each false alarm to be subtracted from the total twelve (12) months after its occurrence.

First false alarm-Fire Chief follows up verbally and records incident.

Second false alarm-Fire Chief sends letter indicating possible financial implications.

Third false alarm-\$300.00

For each succeeding false alarm that is determined to be a preventable false alarm, the fee will increase by \$100.00 (example: fourth false alarm=\$400.00, fifth false alarm=\$500.00)

7. **Miscellaneous**

- Posting of fire watch under the Fire Watch/Scene Protection Fees shall be charged \$75.00 per hour, per vehicle and a 15 % administration fee.
- Foam Class A or B used at Emergency Scene – billed at replacement cost per litre

- (e) Inspection requested and not ready: a fee of \$75.00 shall apply.
