BY-LAW NO. 160-2015

To Establish Rates for Licences and User Fees in the Municipality of North Perth

WHEREAS Section 220.12 of The Municipal Act authorizes a municipality and local Board to pass by-laws imposing fees or charges on any class of persons;

AND WHEREAS Section 69 of The Planning Act authorizes a municipality and local Board to pass by-laws for fees for the processing of applications made in respect of planning matters;

AND WHEREAS the municipality feels it appropriate to set out these charges in one by-law for easy access by ratepayers;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Municipality of North Perth enacts as follows:

The following Schedules apply to various services provided by department:

- Schedule "A" Licence Fees i) Schedule "B" **Administration Fees** ii) Schedule "C" Lottery Licence Fees iii) **Fire Services Fees** Schedule "D" iv) Schedule "E" Planning & Zoning Fees \vee) **Building Permit Fees** Schedule "F" vi) **Development Charges** Schedule "G" vii) Schedule "H" **Recreation Facilities Fees** viii) Public Works Fees Schedule "I" viii) Schedule "J" Landfill Fees ix) Schedule "K" **Dog Licence Fees** X) Schedule "L" **Day Care Centre Fees** xi) Schedule "M" **Police Services Fees** xii) **Cemetery Fees** Schedule "N" xiii) Schedule "O" Library Fees xiv) Schedule "P" Perth Meadows xv)
- 2. Interest on any outstanding account will be charged to the individual at the rate of 2% per month. If this fee is outstanding at the end of the calendar year the amount may be added to the tax roll for collection on any real property in the municipality owned by the applicant and such licence charges and user fees may be collected in like manner as municipal taxes.
- 3. Council will review the rates and fees charged when deemed appropriate.
- 4. This By-Law comes into force on January 1st, 2016.
- 5. By-law No. 24-2006 as amended of the Municipality of North Perth is hereby repealed.
- 6. This By-law shall be known as the "Fees and Licenses By-law".
