Week 2: Fire Camp - Fire Hall

Monday, July 7th, 2025: Get ready for a week of fire fighter-filled fun! To kick off our week, we will begin by creating our fire squads and getting to know the important rules for the week. We will then do a fun obstacle course and agility testing with the firefighters. After lunch, we will do a fire station scavenger hunt and end the day with some free play.



Tuesday, July 8th, 2025: Get ready for some more fire adventures! Today, we will get to participate in some important fire extinguisher training to ensure we know how to properly respond to certain emergencies. Then, we will learn about the different ropes and knots firefighters use and turn them into our very own keychains! We will then head to the Kinsmen Pool to cool off after our hard work and end our day with some free play.

Wednesday, July 9th, 2025: To kick off our third day of Fire Camp, we will play a fun game of "Putting Out the Fires" before a search and rescue exercise using a TIC/drone. After this, we will learn about campfire safety and the burn by-law. After lunch, we will look for the different burn by-law violations found outside the fire station with Fire Chief Pape using cameras. Then we will do our kindness initiative and end with free play.



Thursday, July 10th, 2025: Today is all about search and rescue! Our morning will start with a game of Emergency Call followed by a craft. Then, we will talk about hazards in the kitchen and prepare a taco lunch and some sugar cookies. After lunch, we will head to the Kinsmen Pool to cool off and return to decorate our cookies. Our day will end with free play.

Friday, July 11th, 2025: To end our week at the fire hall, we will complete a doll house fire demonstration and learn about the different elements that can help us control the damage caused by fire. We will then enjoy a campfire cookout where the Fire Department will provide hot dogs and s'mores, putting all our campfire safety learning to use! After lunch, we will do a Bucket Brigade and see which team can get the most amount of water to their teammates in the shortest amount of time. We will then end our day with some campfire cupcake decorating and free play.
