Mayor's Task Force on Affordable Housing

The Municipality of North Perth established the Mayor's Task Force on Affordable Housing which focused their efforts on resolving the current issues surrounding affordable housing. Final recommendations have been presented to Council and work plans and budgets will be considered for Budget 2022.

As the result of a partnership between the City of Stratford, United Way, Family Services Perth Huron and the Municipality of North Perth, a Community Based Social Worker is being hired to support the North Perth Community, including the homeless population.

North Perth Community Hub

In partnership with United Way Perth-Huron, the Municipality of North Perth along with the North Perth Public Library continue to move forward with progress on creating a community hub. Most recent discussions have included the possibility of incorporating housing into the plans for the Community Hub project.

The Standing Committee on Affordable/Attainable Housing (CAAH) for the County of Perth provides County Council with information, advice and recommendations on matters relating to the creation, expansion and retention of affordable, attainable and rentable housing in the County of Perth.

- 1. Creating 115 new attainable housing units;
- 2. Introducing incentives to encourage attainable housing development;
- 3. Developing a coordinated response to homelessness;
- 4. Launching programs designed to assist households experiencing homelessness based on their level of need;
- 5. Implementing initiatives to preserve our existing community housing stock
