

Camp Ready?

To ensure the success of every participant, it's essential that all individuals are 'Camp Ready'!

Participants are 'Camp Ready' if they can:

- Follow directions and instructions given to a large group by a staff person
- Independently participate and safely join in activities such as indoor and outdoor games, crafts, swimming, outings, etc.
- Safely follow the rules of the road during outings and walk as a group following the leader's direction
- Independently use public washroom facilities
- Comfortable and able to interact in a group environment
- Remain within the designated program location and transition areas at all times
- Reliably communicate their wants and needs
- Interact and participate in the program in a way that is safe for themselves and others

If a participant requires assistance with one or more of the 'Camp Ready' criteria above, please see our Inclusion Services section for support options. *Space is limited and not guaranteed!*



Behaviour Management & Expectations:

The Municipality's goal is to provide a safe, secure, and healthy environment for all children. The RZone Policy, camp rules, and regulations are designed for all campers and staff safety. Parents/Guardians are required to review and sign off on acknowledgment of this policy at the time of registration. Failure to follow the RZone policy may result in the removal of the program without refund.

RZone: The RZone procedure applies to all Municipal spaces and programs. The RZone enforces a set of expectations around violence, vandalism and inappropriate behaviour for participants and the public.

Drop-Off, Pick-up, Absenteeism

A sign-in and sign-out procedure has been established for all camps. Parents are kindly asked to drop off and pick up their children at the approved pre-registered time. Late pick-ups increase our staff costs; therefore, an administrative fee will apply.

If you know ahead of time that your child will miss a day of camp or will be absent due to unforeseen circumstances, please notify us by calling the camp phone at 519-573-2532 or 519-291-7691.

Safety

Our camp rules and regulations are designed for your child's safety. Camp leaders will review the rules regularly at camp. No child will be allowed to wander off unsupervised or leave the group at any time without permission. To ensure participant health and safety, please inform staff in advance of any allergies, medical conditions, or behavioural concerns your child may have. We reserve the right to dismiss a camper who refuses to abide by these policies or does not adjust to the group programming.

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Payment & Fee Policy

Registered programs are considered paid at the time of registration, with payment due before the program begins. Program fees are calculated based on the registered program. Fee charges are reviewed annually and posted on our website. The fees are determined by operating costs and the average cost per registrant. To keep fees reasonable and to secure the registrant's spot, payment must be made before the program starts. Refunds will not be issued for withdrawal from the program, or for alternate days and/or absences due to illness, vacation, or other reasons. (See below for details)

Specialty Camps:

Payment is due at the time of registration through the Univerus Software.

Daily/Weekly Camps:

A Payment Plan is set at the time of registration with automatic payment applied 30 days in advance through the client's Univerus Registration Account.



Refunds/Credits

Refunds will not be issued for withdrawal of program, alternate days and/or absent days due to illness, vacation, or other events. Registrants are required to pay for any program the participant is registered to attend.



Sick & Absent Days

No credit is given for sick or absent days. Registrants are expected to pay for any days the participant is absent in which they are enrolled to attend.

Invoice/Payment

An invoice will be populated at the time of registration. Payment will be completed online as applicable. To view registered program invoices:

- ✓ 1. Log on to Univerus
- ✓ 2. Under "My Account" click the "Account Tab"
- ✓ 3. Registered programs will be listed
- ✓ 4. Click the "Green Button" under the function column, click "View" or "PAY"
- ✓ 5. Payment options will be prompted.



Cancellations

For medical emergencies, accounts will be reviewed and credits determined at the discretion of North Perth. Admin Fee will apply.



North Perth Program Cancellation

The Municipality of North Perth reserves the right to cancel any program that fails to meet the minimum registration numbers or unforeseen circumstances (i.e. instructor illness, facility availability, etc). In the event a program is cancelled by the Municipality, it may be rescheduled/transferred, or a credit will be issued to the registrant's Univerus Account.
