

RED MAPLE (*Acer rubrum*)

- Thrives in moist soil but is tolerant of occasional drought
- Grows best in full sun
- Green leaves in spring and summer that turn red and orange in autumn
- can attain a mature height up to 25 meters
- CAUTIONS: branches on red maples can get weak and are prone to falling in windstorms



WHITE SPRUCE (*Picea glauca*)

- Tolerates a range of moisture levels and can grow in almost any soil type
- Tolerates shade and sun
- Can attain a mature height of 24 metres
- CAUTIONS: while young, white spruce are sensitive to frost damage – plant in a protected area



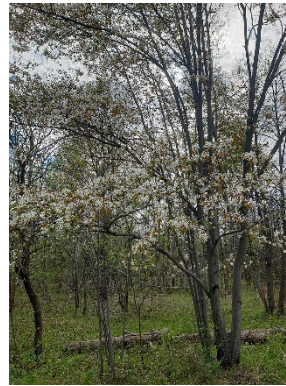
SUGAR MAPLE (*Acer saccharum*)

- Thrives in moist, yet well drained soil
- Grows better in full sun but will tolerate some shade
- Can attain a mature height up to 35 meters
- CAUTIONS: deep roots – do not plant close to septic tanks or underground infrastructure



SERVICEBERRY (*Amelanchier arborea*)

- Thrives in moist to dry soil – adaptable
- Grows in partial shade to full sun
- Reaches heights of up to 12 metres
- CAUTIONS: These trees produce berries in late spring to early summer. As the berries fall, they can create a seasonal cleanup requirement



EASTERN WHITE CEDAR (*Thuja occidentalis*)

- Thrives in a variety of soil types and prefers moist soil
- Grows best in full sun, but can also tolerate some shade
- Can attain a mature height up to 15 meters tall
- CAUTIONS: does not tolerate road salt – do not plant near roads



TULIP TREE (*Liriodendron tulipifera*)

- Thrives in sandy, loamy soil, needs a lot of moisture in the summertime
- Grows best in full sun
- Can attain a mature height up to 35 meters tall
- CAUTIONS: needs deep, rich soil. Fast growing with vast root systems
